The past year has been one of steady and purposeful progress for our hospital, not only in how we grow, but in how we continue to serve.

Our focus remains clear, to deliver safe, high-quality, and compassionate healthcare that is accessible to all. As we strengthen our clinical capabilities and expand our facilities, we do so with intention ensuring that every step forward translates into better care, not just greater scale.

In 2025, this commitment was reflected in both our clinical work and our charitable efforts. Together with our donors and partners, we raised **RM 3,475,573** and disbursed **RM 3,197,996** supporting **251 beneficiaries** in accessing the treatment they needed. Beyond the figures, these represent lives touched, burdens eased, and families given renewed hope.

Year 2025 also marked the introduction of the **Charity Green Parade**, a new initiative that brought together individuals, families, and organisations in a shared expression of care and community. Alongside this, significant fundraisers such as **Charity Heart 2 Heart** and **MENTion It: Building Compassion, Health and Strength** continued to gain momentum, reinforcing the impact of collective giving.

Beyond fundraising, our **Corporate Social Responsibility** and community health initiatives remain an integral part of our work. Through outreach programmes, health screenings, and education efforts, we continue to extend care beyond our hospital walls, reaching communities, encouraging early intervention, and promoting long-term well-being.

As we continue to grow, we remain deliberate in our approach. Growth, for us, is not defined by expansion alone, but by our ability to deliver care that is efficient, sustainable, and centred on the needs of our patients. Every investment we make is guided by this principle.

Dr. J. Earl Gardner Fund

Provides free or subsidised medical treatment to needy patients suffering from chronic illness in areas of tumour, cleft palate repair, major limb amputation, scoliosis, stroke etc

Cancer Fund

Provide free or subsidised medical treatment to needy cancer patients to undergo cancer related treatment.

Patient Heart Fund

Provides free or subsidised medical treatment to needy patients suffering from heart ailments.

Welfare Fund

Income received by Hospital during Sabbath (sunset Friday to sunset Saturday) are channelled towards this fund which provides free or subsidised medical treatment to assists needy patients in dialysis, cataract surgery, admission bills and minor surgeries.

General Fund

The Medical Welfare Services

The hospital's Medical Welfare Services Unit was established in 1997 to help the poor and needy with medical assistance.

The Medical Welfare Services team assists patients and/or patients' relatives in seeking the appropriate healthcare treatment in PAH. The Medical Welfare Officer also liaises with doctors, nurses, other health professionals, as well as community resources and welfare agents in providing solutions for patients who are unable to meet medical costs. The Medical Welfare Services unit is a caring and responsive team that serves the local community who are in need of medical assistance by offering medical financial aid.

As responsible stewards of the charity funds, the team ensures accountability and visibility for each case presented to the relevant committee for fund disbursement.

Lov'Earth CSR Recycling Project

"Small acts, when multiplied by many, can transform the world."

Lov'Earth CSR Recycling Project, a collective effort of PAH staff, raised a total of **RM2,082.24** in support of the **Penang Cerebral Palsy (Spastic) Children's Association**.

This initiative demonstrated how small, consistent actions, when embraced by many, could create meaningful impact. We extend our heartfelt appreciation to every staff member who contributed, showing how compassion, when combined with collective action, could make a lasting difference in the lives of others.

On 23 June 2025, our Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Albin Phua, together with staff representatives, visited the Penang Cerebral Palsy Children's Association for a simple yet heart-warming handover ceremony. Handicraft materials and daily essentials, purchased using the funds raised, were presented in support of the students and the centre's ongoing programmes.

The joyful smiles of the students and the warmth felt at the centre served as a powerful reminder that even the simplest act, such as recycling, could extend far beyond environmental responsibility to touch lives within our community.

Through the incredible participation and shared spirit of our staff, this initiative truly transformed waste into hope, benefiting not only the environment, but also the people we are privileged to serve.





Rebuilding Together in Faith and Hope

In August 2025, a fire broke out at Pontian Adventist Kindergarten, destroying much of the classroom equipment and learning materials. The incident deeply affected the children and educators, disrupting a space that had been a place of growth, care, and learning.

Through the generosity of PAH staff and doctors, together with support from our Recycling Fund, a total of **RM28,325** was raised to help refurbish the affected classrooms. This collective effort enabled the replacement of essential furniture and learning resources, allowing the kindergarten to resume its daily activities.

Today, it is both a joy and a privilege to see the children back in their classrooms, their smiles brighter than ever, and their learning renewed. This outcome was made possible by the kindness and compassion of our staff, whose willingness to give ensured that the children could return to a safe and nurturing environment.

Moments such as these remind us that, as one Adventist family, we walk together in faith, hope, and love, supporting one another through challenges and rebuilding with purpose and care.



Charity Car Boot Sale 2.0: Merry Wheels Market

The Charity Car Boot Sale 2.0: Merry Wheels Market was a heart-warming success, raising **RM14,572** in support of our nursing students' mission trip to Hatyai. The funds raised were directed towards post-flood community outreach, enabling the students to assist families, support clean-up efforts, and extend care where it was most needed.

The event was filled with festive cheer, made memorable by beautifully decorated stalls, favourable weather, and the shared enthusiasm of everyone involved. It truly reflected the spirit of Corporate Social Responsibility, as staff from various departments came together to organise and run the market despite their busy schedules.

To mark the conclusion of this meaningful initiative, a handover ceremony was held with the presentation of a mock cheque to the Adventist College of Nursing & Health Sciences, symbolising our collective support for the students' upcoming mission.

As shared by nursing student Alicia (A member of Mission Trip):

"This mission is about more than giving goods; it is about bringing hope, comfort, and light to people whose lives have been heavily impacted. In short, this fundraising is what allows us to stand beside these communities in a practical and heartfelt way. It becomes the bridge that connects your generosity to their needs, turning simple items into powerful reminders that they are not alone."





A Gift of Sight

100 Free Cataract Program



In conjunction with our 100th Anniversary, the hospital launched the **100 Free Cataract Surgeries Programme** as a meaningful initiative to give back to the community. This programme was introduced to provide free cataract surgeries for B40 patients, ensuring that financial limitations did not stand in the way of essential, sight-restoring care.

The response was immediate and encouraging. All 100 surgery slots were fully taken up within the first quarter of the year, reflecting the pressing need for accessible eye care, particularly among the elderly.

Through the dedication and coordinated efforts of our doctors, nurses, and healthcare teams, each patient

underwent comprehensive assessments, careful follow-ups, and safe surgical procedures. By December, the final case was successfully completed, marking the full completion of this milestone programme. A total of **RM531,762** was disbursed to cover the cost of surgeries and post-operative follow-up care, ensuring patients received continuous and comprehensive treatment.

It has been both an honour and a privilege to serve through this initiative. Most rewarding of all was seeing many elderly patients regain their sight, restoring not only vision, but also independence, confidence, and quality of life.

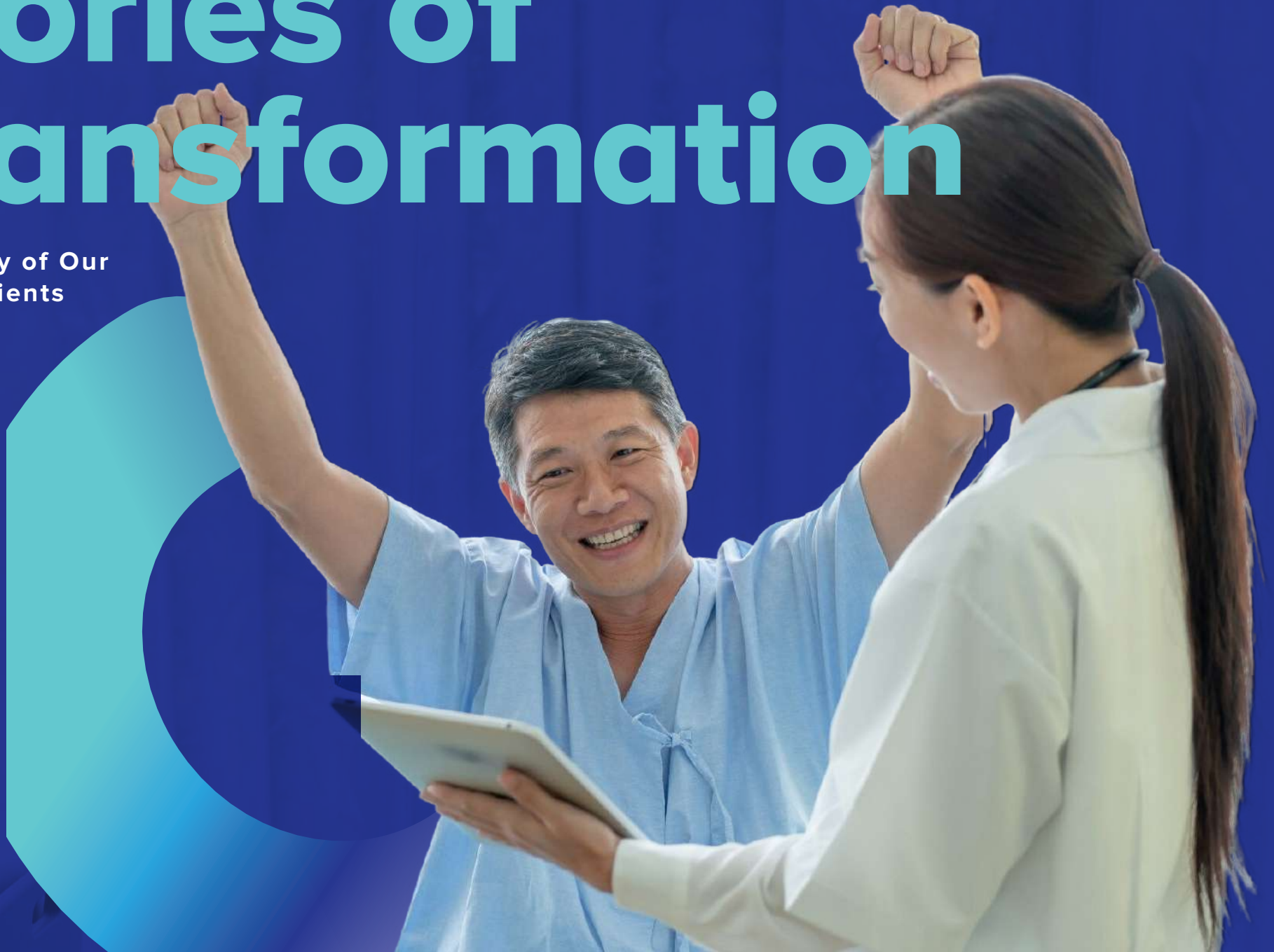

“I Found A Job!”

Dr. J. Earl Gardner Fund

When 35-year-old Mr Ganesh first approached our charity team, his request was simple yet heavy with emotion. He was asking for help with a problem that had troubled him for a long time. It had quietly taken away his dignity, confidence and ability to move forward with life.

In February 2024, a road accident left him with serious injuries to his left arm, left leg, and genital area. He was initially treated at government hospital, where he underwent multiple surgeries on his hand and leg, as well as a urethrotomy. Despite these interventions, his condition did not improve as hoped. He continued to experience difficulty passing urine and had to rely on a urinary catheter for more than five months.

Living with a catheter took a heavy toll on him, both physically and emotionally. Feeling discouraged and unsure of his options, he sought a second opinion at Penang Adventist Hospital. After further assessment, he was diagnosed with bulbar urethral stricture and a buccal mucosal graft urethroplasty was recommended. Unfortunately, the cost of the surgery was beyond his financial means.

Since the accident, he has been unemployed, as employers were unwilling to hire him while he depended on a catheter. At the time, he was staying with his brother’s family. His brother, the sole breadwinner, was already supporting his own children as well as two orphaned niece and nephew, placing the household under considerable financial strain.

Recognizing the urgency of his condition and the impact it had on his ability to return to normal life, **the charity fund provided full financial assistance amounting to RM 26,215, covering 100% of the treatment cost.** Following the surgery, a one-week course of antibiotic injections and several follow-up visits, his recovery progressed well.

Today, the change in his life is evident. The pain and discomfort that once defined his days are gone, and his daily routines have returned to normal. In December 2025, we were heartened to learn that he had secured a job as a security guard, marking an important step towards independence. He shared his gratitude with us, expressing how relieved and happy he feels to have his life back.



A Second Chance at Childhood

December 2024 was a terrifying month for eight-year-old Mickha and her family. While riding pillion with her uncle, she was involved in a road accident. She was thrown off the motorbike, her helmet came off and she landed unconscious.

Rushed to Penang Adventist Hospital, Mickha was bleeding and in critical condition. The doctors quickly discovered brain injuries and a fractured left leg. She had a right frontal acute epidural hematoma, a frontoparietal skull fracture, and a broken tibia. Suddenly, this little girl, who had spent her days running and laughing, was fighting for her life.

Her mother was terrified, feeling helpless. How could she possibly afford the emergency surgery her daughter desperately needed, with a cost far beyond the family's modest income? With little savings and the support of her uncle, the hospital's medical charity stepping in at this critical moment, Mickha was able to receive the care she needed without delay.

The surgery was successful, and soon after, the **charity approved RM14,448.80, covering 100%, the full cost of Mickha's hospital bill.**

Today, Mickha is recovering beautifully. She has returned to school, slowly getting back her cheerful energy. Her ordeal left her with a new understanding of community and kindness. She recently joined our Charity Green Parade, eager to give back and share the same kindness that once saved her life.

Accidents may come unexpectedly, but planning ahead with an emergency fund and accessing timely support can save lives.



Strength Beyond Illness

Cancer Fund



Madam Teoh has been a cheerful and resilient cancer survivor for more than 10 years. When she was first diagnosed with breast cancer in 2014, and facing a relapse in 2016, she never imagined how long and challenging the journey ahead would be...

In 2024, the challenge deepened. The cancer had metastasized to her spine, liver, and lungs. Her days have since been shaped by chemotherapy, targeted therapy, injections, and daily medication. Still, she chose to face it quietly and bravely, learning to live alongside treatments and the uncertainty.

However, what makes her journey even more challenging is that she is not only a patient, but also a caregiver. Since 2019, her husband has been living with the after-effects of a stroke and requires regular dialysis. Managing illness is never easy for a family, physically, mentally, and financially. When two people in the same household require long-term care, the burden quietly grows heavier each day.

She shared that there are days when exhaustion sets in, days when her body feels weak and her heart feels heavy. What saddens her most is thinking about her children, knowing the burden they carry.

And yet, she is thankful for having a devoted son and a caring daughter who stand by the family with love and strength.

As her treatment continued, the financial pressure on the family grew heavier. Not wanting her children to carry the burden alone, Madam Teoh sought help. She was deeply thankful when **charity approved RM 50,000 to help cover part (46%) of her medical expenses**, significantly easing the pressure on her family.

Despite all she has been through, Madam Teoh remains positive. She manages her treatments diligently, looks after her husband with care, and faces each day with quiet determination. And because of her own experiences, she understands more than most how important mindset is, especially during illness. She willingly shares her journey and thoughts with other cancer patients, hoping her story can encourage them to stay strong and not lose hope.

Her journey is deeply inspiring, reminds us that courage does not always roar. Sometimes, it is simply the choice to keep going, loving, caring, and hoping. We wish Madam Teoh continued strength, peace, and gentler days ahead.

Quiet Endurance – An Asian Kind of Love

In June 2025, Madam Lim was diagnosed with stage 3 breast cancer. Her treatment plan was six cycles of chemotherapy and targeted therapy, followed by breast removal surgery and later radiotherapy. As she has always been afraid of falling sick since young, she naturally felt scared and uncertain about her illness and the treatment ahead.

Madam Lim, 62, is a mother of two. For over 20 years, she has been caring for her daughter who is both mentally and physically differently abled. Life has never been easy, but she has been fortunate to have a son who has always stood by her side. After her diagnosis, he accompanied her to every treatment. He was always a positive and comforting presence to her mother.

Behind their smiles at each other, both mother and son kept their struggles to themselves. Out of love, Madam Lim pretended to be steady, not wanting to worry her son. Similarly, her son remained silent about the financial stress of her treatments, fearing it would affect her mood. Both thought, “If I don’t say anything, the other will be okay.” This is a very human response. Yet this quiet endurance slowly deepened their stress and loneliness.

Perhaps because the medical welfare officer was a stranger, they finally felt able to share the burdens they had been carrying alone. For the first time, they opened up about the fear, exhaustion and worry that they had weighed on them. It was a huge relief. Gratefully, the hospital’s charity team was able to step in, offering support not only for treatment costs but also emotional guidance and companionship. **Madam Lim received RM50,000, covering 65.7% of her total treatment cost.** Most importantly, they realized they were not alone.

Madam Lim’s treatment is ongoing, but the mother and son are now more open with each other, sharing and caring in ways they had never done before. Through this experience, they discovered that opening up did not diminish their love, it strengthened it.

We don't want 50/50

Patient Heart Fund



It started quietly. Mr Cheah thought shortness of breath was just fatigue catching up with him. But when the episodes became persistent, a routine check revealed the truth: fluid in his lungs, failing heart valves, and three severe artery blockages, which are mitral and tricuspid regurgitation. Life was literally hanging by a heartbeat.

The solution was clear, but the cost was overwhelming. Surgery had to happen immediately, yet RM115,000 loomed over the family like an impossible mountain. His wife remembers the sleepless nights, torn between fear of losing him and fear of the cost. With time running out, the family borrowed what they could to proceed with surgery, while the hospital's *Charity Fund stepped in to cover RM50,000 (43% of the cost)*, giving them both relief and hope.

Mr Cheah survived. Through the haze of fear and relief, Mr Cheah began to understand something important. Heart conditions can progress silently, and symptoms like unusual fatigue, shortness of breath, or swelling should never be ignored. These whispers from the body are never '50/50'. Ignoring them can mean the difference between life and death. Small, everyday choices like maintaining a healthy diet, exercising, controlling blood pressure and cholesterol truly matter.

He is now recovering slowly. Yet the family finds small moments of gratitude, for laughter during dinner, for a deep breath taken without pain, and for the simple miracle of another day together.

Life is fragile, but action changes everything. We don't want 50/50, because when it comes to the heart, there is no room for chance.

The Cost of Waiting, The Value of Acting

Welfare Fund



For Madam Krishnaammah, daily life had become a series of careful calculations. At 74, even small movements, such as a few steps across the room, standing at the stove, or tidying the house, came with effort. The tightness in her chest was constant and exhaustion followed her everywhere. Yet more than the pain, it was the fear that lingered. What if I don't have much time left with my children?

Her condition, ischemic heart disease with severe aortic stenosis, had been diagnosed early in September 2023. Over the following months, her heart struggled to keep up. Aortic stenosis occurs when the heart's main valve narrows, reducing blood flow and forcing the heart to work harder. Left untreated, it can lead to heart failure or sudden complications.

A widow with three children, Madam Krishnaammah only dared to explore options at government hospitals, but a surgery date was never given. Meanwhile, she continued regular check-ups and medication, managing symptoms while waiting and hoping.

As the pain worsened, she decided to consult a cardiologist at Penang Adventist Hospital in July 2025. She was advised to undergo Aortic Valve Replacement and Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG) surgery. The estimated cost of RM120,000 felt overwhelming.

Determined not to let time decide for them, her children chose to act. They planned to self-fund part of the treatment through borrowings from relatives and sought help from the Penang Adventist Hospital Charity Fund to bridge the gap. **With RM50,000 approved, covering 56.6% of the cost**, the long wait finally gave way to action, and surgery could proceed.

Finally, the crushing tightness eased. Breathing no longer felt like work. Slowly, Madam Krishnaammah returned to the rhythms of daily life, cooking again, moving about her home and spending unhurried moments with her children and grandchildren.

"After everything, I realize health is the most important," she said softly. "Luckily, my children found ways for me to undergo surgery. If no action had been taken, I would have suffered for so long."

The family remains deeply grateful for the Charity Fund. Even though the maximum support is RM50,000 and may not cover the entire cost, it offers hope and relief to many.

Mr Lem Ba Bi learned about the 100 Free Cataract Surgery Program through newspaper. He reached out to apply and was later entitled to the program. When we first met Mr Lem, we were struck by his positive spirit. Standing tall on one leg, his confidence and charm were unmistakable. Despite physical challenges and living on a limited income, he remains independent and creative.

He shared with us his passion for DIY handicrafts, particularly artworks made from coconuts, a skill he has honed through years of experience. During each visit to the hospital, he would bring along some of his handmade creations as a token of appreciation for the charity team and his attending doctor. These artworks were later sold at Charity Car Boot Sale 2.0, with the proceeds contributed to support the cause.

Mr Lem expressed deep gratitude for receiving RM 5,225.30, 100% of the cataract surgery and treatment assistance. He shared that it was something he would not have been able to afford otherwise. His appreciation was heartfelt, he even took the time to write a personal letter to convey his thanks.

With improved eyesight, he has resumed selling his artwork at various markets, allowing him to remain self-reliant. He also makes donations to the hospital fund when he is able, choosing to give back in his own way.

A Clearer Path Forward

Madam Sumathi learned about the 100 Free Cataract Surgery Program through a pastor whom she has known for many years. She comes from a B40 household, with the family relying solely on her husband as the main source of income.

She had been experiencing blurred vision for many years, yet she never imagined that her condition could be treated. With limited information and resources, she was only aware of government hospital as an option and was unsure where else to seek medical support.

In addition to suffering from severe cataracts in both eyes, with one eye having completely lost vision, Madam Sumathi is also undergoing cancer treatment at government hospital. Her medical condition has affected her daily life significantly, requiring the use of urine and fecal bags as well as ongoing follow-up care.

When she was introduced to PAH, the doctor advised that urgent cataract surgery for both eyes was necessary. Due to the severity, treating only one eye was not a viable option. ***The charity fund therefore supported RM 14,322.80, the full (100%) treatment cost for both eyes,*** enabling her to proceed with the recommended surgeries.

Madam Sumathi expressed gratitude for the assistance she received. She shared that although she continues to face multiple health challenges, regaining her sight has lifted one of the heaviest burdens in her life. Now, she remains hopeful to continue her medical journey and face the challenges ahead with strength and resilience.

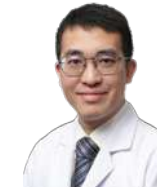
